In Mexico, PRASAD offers free eye surgeries through PRASAD de México, and dental services to underprivileged children in the U.S. through PRASAD Children's Dental Health Program.

2017 PROGRAM SERVICE ACCOMPLISHMENTS

In India, PRASAD has programs that meet the needs of the people in the Tansa Valley. These include healthcare initiatives focusing on general, specialized and preventative care, a nutrition program, farming initiatives, self-help groups and community development:


- The medical program received over 69,000 visits.
- Nearly 3,700 people received screenings, medical care and health education from the mobile hospital.
- Performed 649 free cataract surgeries
- The nutrition program provided more than 134,000 servings of milk and nutritional snacks to overcome childhood malnutrition
- Provided training to over 2,800 participating in Self Help Groups.


In the United States, PRASAD Children's Dental Health Program provided more than 3,600 children with dental health education and dental care.


PRASAD de México provided 1,244 free eye surgeries for adults with cataracts and children with strabismus.
